

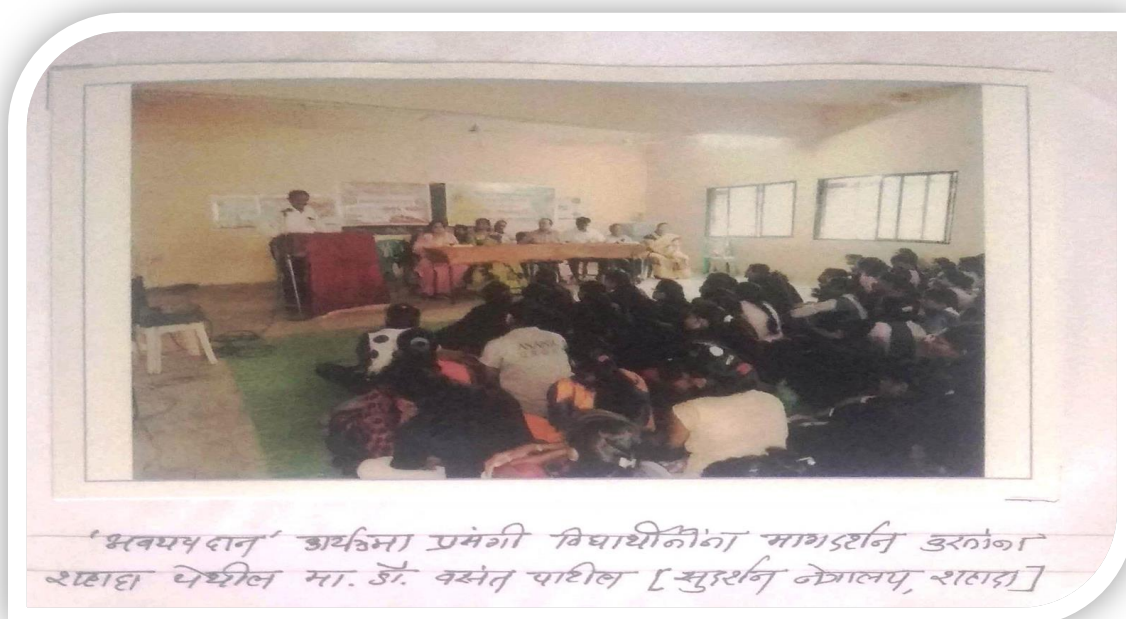

Lectures:

Rally:

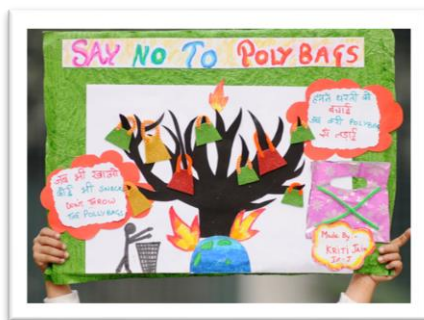
